

## TEAMGOLDUSA PARENT & SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Purpose Parents and guardians are critical partners in building a positive, athlete-centric culture. This Code of Conduct describes how parents and spectators are expected to support athletes, coaches, and the TEAMGOLDUSA community.

- 1. Core Principles As a parent/guardian or spectator, I will: Support my swimmer's long-term development, not just short-term results. Let coaches coach, officials officiate, and athletes compete. Model respect, integrity, and good sportsmanship at all times. Support Safe Sport and MAAPP boundaries, including communication and travel rules.
- 2. At Practices & Meets I will: Refrain from coaching my swimmer from the stands or pool deck. Cheer positively for all swimmers; never ridicule, shout at, or embarrass any athlete.
  Respect officials and accept their decisions without confrontation. Follow facility rules and staff directions at all times. Keep personal conversations and behavior appropriate for a youth sports environment.
- 3. Communication & Conflict I will: Address concerns or questions calmly and at appropriate times, not during meets or in front of athletes. Use the appropriate channels: coach first for training issues, then Safe Sport Coordinator or board if needed. Avoid posting negative comments about athletes, coaches, officials, or families on social media. Discuss concerns with my swimmer in a supportive way, avoiding blame or shame.
- 4. Safe Sport & MAAPP I understand and support: USA Swimming's Safe Sport Program and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP). Limits on one-on-one interactions between adults and minor athletes. The need for observable and interruptible interactions, especially in vehicles, locker rooms, and electronic communications. My responsibility to report any suspected abuse, misconduct, or policy violations in good faith.
- 5. Partnership with Coaches and the Team I will: Ensure my swimmer arrives on time, prepared, and safely leaves the facility after practices and meets. Encourage my swimmer to communicate with coaches respectfully about goals and progress. Volunteer when able to support meets, events, and team operations. Help create a welcoming environment for new families.
- 6. Consequences I understand that failing to follow this Code of Conduct may result in: Verbal or written warnings. Being asked to leave a practice, meet, or event. Restrictions on attending team activities. Possible removal of my swimmer from the team in serious or repeated cases.
- 7. Acknowledgment & Signature I have read and understand the TEAMGOLDUSA Parent & Spectator Code of Conduct. I agree to follow these expectations and support a positive environment for all swimmers.
